BREEDING SHED REQUIREMENTS

KODIAK KOWBOY & PIONEER OF THE NILE MARES NEED A BREEDING SOUNDNESS ON FIRST TRIP

1. **MAIDEN AND BARREN MARES:** All MAIDEN and BARREN mares must be accompanied by a negative uterine culture, taken within 30 days of first breeding, by a licensed veterinarian. Negative uterine culture required for **ALL** return covers.

(All maiden mares must be jumped before coming to the breeding shed. NO EXCEPTIONS!)

2. **FOALING MARES:** A culture is not necessary for the first cover. Negative uterine culture required for **ALL** return covers.

All Mares coming to the breeding shed are required to be vaccinated for Equine Herpes Virus Type – 1 (i.e. Rhinomune, Pneumobort-K, etc.) from 14-90 days before breeding. A veterinary statement to this effect MUST be furnished by the farm and MUST accompany the mare to the breeding shed each visit.

3. **IDENTIFICATION:** YOUR MARE WILL NOT BE BRED UNLESS SHE CAN BE IDENTIFIED THROUGH EITHER A NECK STRAP OR HALTER NAME PLATE.

4. **DOMESTIC MARES – CEM:** There will be no CEM requirements for any DOMESTIC MARE.

5. **IMPORTED MARES – CEM:** A copy of the quarantine release MUST accompany these mares to the breeding shed at the time of their first cover. A quarantine release may be obtained by collecting a set of cultures from the clitoral fossa and sinuses on day 1, day 4, and day 7. Then scrub and pack the clitoral fossa and sinuses on day 7,8,9,10 and 11. When the final set of culture reports are received, the attending vet should complete, sign and forward the worksheet to the State Veterinarian's office. A quarantine release will then be returned to the farm. This release should accompany the mare to the breeding shed. The three mares following the import mare bred to the same stallion shall have a CF test taken 15-40 days post-breeding. www.kyagr.com

Any mare that is an import mare that has not previously been bred in the United States must be reported at the time the mare is booked to be bred.

6. **EVA:** All Vinery Stallions have been vaccinated against EVA. Current requirements are as follows:

- a) No mare vaccinated against for EVA for less than 28 days will be bred.
- b) Any mare, which is EVA positive or suspicious without proof of being sero negative prior to vaccination, must be reported at the time the mare is booked to be bred. This, of course, includes any mare, which has shown symptoms of EVA at any time. All such mares will be bred the last session of the day after the shed has been cleared of all other mares.

(In the event of an EVA outbreak during the breeding season, these requirements will be subject to change.)

Vinery will follow the recommendations of the USDA and Kentucky Department of Agriculture with regard to CEM & EVA

7. We will not breed any mares without a **SIGNED CONTRACT OR WRITTEN** authorization from a shareholder or stallion owner or a **MARE INFORMATION SHEET!!!**
